



DUCK, DUCK, GOOSE

Although you may have learned this game in elementary school, “Duck, Duck, Goose” is a classic that’s fun for all ages.

Step 1: Players sit in a circle, facing in. One player is chosen to be “it” and starts the game.

Step 2: “It” slowly walks around the outside of the circle. As they pass each player, they tap them gently on the head while saying “duck” for each person.

Step 3: “It” chooses who they would like to name the “goose.” When they tap a player and say “goose” instead of “duck,” that player must jump up and chase “it” around the circle and try to tag them.

Step 4: If “it” gets to the goose’s empty spot before being tagged, then the goose becomes “it.”

Step 5: Continue the game for as long as you’d like (or until everyone is tired!).
